

## Embroidery Cross Stitch Pouch

### Materials

Finished product of the cross stitch

25cm X 19 cm fabrics

1 zipper 7 inch long

28cm X 4cm fabric

28cm X 1cm white cloth



### Instructions

1. Cut the cross stitch cloth to 25cm x 19cm and ensure that the name Dorothy and flower are centralize.
2. Pin the cross stitch cloth on the fabric and cut the fabric cloth same size as the cross stitch.
3. Cut another strip of pink fabric measuring 28cm x 4cm for the strap at the side of the bag.
4. Cut another white strip of white cloth measuring 28cm x 1cm.
5. Place the white strip of cloth in the middle of the pink fabric and fold both side of the pink fabric on the white strip cloth. Next fold the pink fabric together and used a clip to secure the strip.

6. Sew the strip of fabric until the end of the strip. Turn the strip and sew another time. Fold the strip into half and sew at the end of the strip.
7. Place the flower fabric side on the cross stitch (cross stitch face the flower fabric) and open up the zipper and ensure zipper opening at the Dorothy side. Clip the zipper to the fabric.
8. Install a zipper foot on your sewing machine. Remove the clip from the fabric and sew the fabric with the zipper.
9. Flip open the fabric and open up the zipper. Sew the cross stitch side on the zipper to reinforce the sewing.
10. If the zipper get in the way to unzip the zipper and resume sewing.
11. Turn the fabric over and pull the zipper 1/3 down.
12. Pull the zipper all the way to the end and sew the other side of the zipper.
13. When reaching almost the end of the sewing pull the zipper away and resume sewing until the end. Trim away excess thread.
14. Overturn the cross stitch.
15. Place the pink fabric on the other side of the zip and resume sewing.
16. When reaching almost the end of the sewing pull the zipper away and resume sewing until the end. Trim away excess thread.
17. Overturn the fabric.
18. Pull the zip open. Sew the edge of the cross stitch until the end. Trim away excess thread.
19. Overturn the cross stitch and place the strip 1.5cm down from the top of the bag. Sew the strip on the cross stitch twice.
20. Used a clip to clip the 2 sides together. Used another 2<sup>nd</sup> clip to clip the other 2 pieces together.
21. Fold the end of the cross stitch inward and used a clip to secure it.
22. Remove the right side of the clip and sew 1/3 of the fabric down to the middle of the cross stitch. Remove the clip at the center and sew to the end.
23. Turn the cross stitch over and sew the cross stitch again until 1/3 of the fabric. Trim away excess thread.
24. Remove the 3<sup>rd</sup> clip and sew 1/3 of the fabric down to the cross stitch. Ensure that the edge of the cross stitch are folded and resume sewing.
25. Turn the cross stitch over and resume sewing at the edge of the cross stitch until 1/3 of the fabric.
26. Fold the fabric toward the inside and sew to the end of the fabric. Turn the fabric and sew the fabric again until the end of the fabric. Trim away excess thread.
27. Fold the other side of the fabric inward and sew the folded edge twice. Trim away excess thread.
28. Used the hole on the fabric and turn cross stitch outside.
29. Used the tweezer to tidy up the corner of the pouch.
30. Change the zipper foot to the sewing foot.
31. Take out the fabric and close up the hole by sewing the fabric together. Fold back the fabric inside the cross stitch pouch.
32. The embroidery cross stitch pouch is completed.
